

How to register your Boxer Puppies

What to do?	Why?
1. a) Join KUSA b) Join a KUSA affiliated Boxer Club of your choice	This is a requirement to register puppies. As a club member you are kept informed of shows, club activities and all Club news.
2. Both stud dog and brood dam must be registered with KUSA.	This is a requirement
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cardiac Murmur Certification form to be completed from age 12 months and before being mated. 	This requirement is not compulsory. The FBCSA Breed Council strongly recommends that stud dogs and brood dams are checked annually.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stud dog and brood dam must be micro-chipped • Hip Certification Certificate 	<p>This is a requirement.</p> <p>This requirement is not compulsory. The FBCSA Breed Council recommends that Boxers used for breeding are x-rayed for hip dysplasia from the age of 12 months onwards. Dogs with D and E hips should not be bred from.</p>
3. Register a KENNEL PREFIX .	This is recommended. The prefix has to be approved by KUSA.
4. When the litter is born please contact FBCSA Breed Council Registrations Secretary to make her aware of the new litter.	As a responsible breeder the onus is on you to contact the FBCSA Breed Council Registrations Secretary to assist with the registration procedure of the litter.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Breeders have the option to advertise their puppies on the FBCSA Breed Council's website at a nominal fee. 	There is no guarantee that the pups will be sold through the website. Photos of individual pups can be placed on the website. The onus is on the breeder to advertise the pups using different media of their choice.
5. Between 6-7 weeks of age puppies must be taken to the local vet for a health check, inoculations, deworming and micro-chipping.	This is a requirement . Please ensure that the puppy veterinary certificate is signed and dated by the veterinarian. Puppies should be dewormed at 2, 4 and 6-7 weeks.
6. Litter inspections	This is not a requirement but some Clubs offer this service where feasible. Photos of puppies showing head and body are required. Please contact the FBCSA Breed Council Registration Secretary and or Club Secretaries if assistance is required. Puppies may only leave the dam earliest at age of 8 weeks .
7. Payments and submission of forms:	Payment must be made to KUSA. All fully completed forms and photos to be received by the FBCSA Breed Council Registration Secretary as soon as possible after visit to veterinarian.
